

How to Invest in Heal Ministry by check:

To invest in Heal Ministry by check, please follow these instructions:

Prepare Your Check:

- Write a check for the amount you wish to donate. Make it payable to "Heal Ministry."
- Include Donation Information:
- In the memo line of the check, you may indicate if your donation is intended for a specific purpose, fund, or project (e.g., "General Fund," "Medical Outreach," etc.).

Mail Your Check:

- Place the check and any accompanying documentation in an envelope.
- Address the Envelope to the following:

Postage and Sending:

- Ensure that you have the necessary postage on the envelope.
- Drop the envelope in a mailbox, or take it to your local post office for mailing.

If you prefer to set up automatic bill pay through your bank*, here's how you can do it:

Log in to Your Bank Account:

- Access your online banking account or visit your bank's website.
- Navigate to Bill Pay or Automatic Payments:
- Look for the "Bill Pay" or "Automatic Payments" section in your online banking dashboard. The exact location may vary based on your bank's website.
- Select the option to add a new payee or biller.
- Enter the following payee Information:

- Set Up Payment Details:
 - Choose the account from which you want the donations to be deducted (your checking account).
 - Set the donation amount, frequency (e.g., monthly), and the start date for your automatic donations.
